Help us Open Up St Mary's

The estimated costs of the works and commissioning the new furniture is £220,000.

Once the works have been completed the church will be redecorated. Any surplus funds raised will be put towards the cost of redecoration, estimated at £80,000, which is a lot less than if the pews were not removed.

Any changes will be done sensitively, and we are proud to have achieved this in the refurbishment of the vestry area in 2018. The enhanced facilities now support the day to day use of the church as well as community events.

As of November 2018, £80,000 has already been raised and a further £30,000 is needed for the appeal to reach the level required for us to approach grant giving organisations who are likely to support this project.

Opening Up St Mary's


The fixed pews will be replaced by specially designed stackable benches which can be temporarily moved to create a flexible open space in the centre of the church. A wooden floor will be installed flush with existing flagstones and improvements made to the heating system.

The church will also be redecorated (last carried out 30 years ago), so that it may remain a welcoming, attractive and affirming place for worship and fellowship. The works proposed will enable the church:

To be the cultural and spiritual heart of our **community** by hosting a wider range of activities such as concerts and exhibitions.

To address social needs. In recognising the fragmentation of society, we endeavour to nurture a deeper sense of community by offering hospitality to various groups in a flexible, accessible space throughout the week.

To serve our growing community by creating a large open area in addition to the Church Hall that can accommodate larger groups, such as pupils at our Church School. Over the years the school has tripled in size and we can no longer accommodate all the pupils in the current pew configuration.
