

In this Notice "parish" means an ecclesiastical parish.

Under section 4 of the Churchwardens Measure 2001, candidates for election must be nominated and seconded in writing by persons entitled to attend the meeting. The nomination paper must include a statement, signed by the person nominated, that he or she is willing to serve as a churchwarden and is not disqualified under section 2(1), (2) or (3) of the Measure. The nomination paper must be received by the minister of the parish before the commencement of the meeting; if there is no minister, it must be received before the commencement of the meeting by the churchwarden who signed the notice convening the meeting.

Attention is drawn to the right of appeal contained in section 5A of the Churchwardens Measure 2001 which may be read at https://www.legislation.qov.uk/ukcm/2001/1/section/5A. This includes appeal against the allowance or disallowance of a vote in an election, and against the result of an election. Advice on the appeal process may be obtained from the Diocesan Registrar if required.
