#### FROM THE PARISH ARCHIVES: REMEMBERING THOSE WHO DIED 1939-1945

The framed Roll of Honour for both World Wars was inscribed in 1954 and is displayed in the north aisle, a memorial to those who died from the parish of Twickenham. A separate Roll of Honour is also on display for those who died in the second World War in whose memory the gates at the entrance to the churchyard were restored along with the wrought-iron lamp above them in 1955. Mandy Hunter remembers the occasion of the dedication of the gates as a significant family event as her uncle, Philip Hunter, was shot down over St Nazaire on 2 April 1943.

I am most grateful to Prof. Jeremy and Sue Hamilton-Miller who have researched the names on the 1939-1945 list. The archives include a card index as well as letters written by bereaved family members to Donald Simpson, the church archivist at that time, who had sent out a request for details to the congregation along with a plea for donations to the fund to restore the gates and lamp. Jeremy and Sue Hamilton-Miller were successful in identifying many of those listed but were puzzled by the names that either could not be identified at all or were not apparently connected to Twickenham.

If anyone has further information about any of those named, it would be very much appreciated, especially if more light could be shed on the names for which there is so far no information. See the full list on the Parish website:

Cristian Sandrin and the English Chamber Orchestra Ensemble perform three iconic Piano Concertos by W.A. Mozart.

Piano Concerto No. 12 in A major K414

Piano Concerto No. 13 in C Major K415

Piano Concerto No. 14 in E-flat major K449

These three virtuoso concertos were written in Vienna between 1782–83 when a newly liberated Mozart was first launching his subscription concerts. They will be performed as a chamber ensemble.

Cristian Sandrin has won many awards, including the Roslyn Tureck Special Prize for the best interpretation of Bach at the 2019 International Piano Competition in Albuquerque NM. Critics on both sides of the Atlantic have praised him for his immaculate technique, crystalline clarity and mature interpretations. He has performed at famous venues across Europe from the Salle Cortot Paris to the Salle Manuel de Falla in Madrid, the Kleiner Konzerthaus Berlin, La Fenice Theatre Venice, the Polish National Philharmonic Hall Warsaw and the BeethovenHaus Bonn. https://www.cristiansandrin.com



Twickenham Guitar Society hosts one of the greatest living classical guitarists in a programme featuring music by Schubert, Piazzolla, Satie, Albéniz, Barrios and more, for this solo guitar recital in the superb acoustics of St Mary's church.

Xuefei Yang is acclaimed as one of the world's finest classical guitarists. Hailed as a musical pioneer, Xuefei was the first-ever guitarist in China to enter a music school, and became the first internationally-recognised Chinese guitarist on the world stage. Her first public

appearance was at the age of ten and her debut in Madrid at the age of 14 was attended by the composer Joaquín Rodrigo and, when John Williams heard her play, he gave two of his own instruments to Beijing's Central Conservatoire especially for her and other advanced students.
