KNITTING GROUP – FRIENDS OF FAITH – NEED NEEDLES AND WOOL

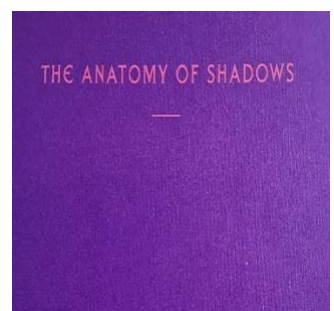
